Per new Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) requirements, the City of Dayton Department of Water is creating an inventory of service lines in order to identify where lead pipes may still exist in the city.

Dayton's treated water does not contain lead. The study we are conducting for our Service Line Compliance Program will help us predict the types of pipes used on private property throughout our service areas.

This property has been selected for a field investigation to identify the type of material used for your water service pipe. The property owner has been informed of this activity and has granted access to this property.
